Platform Benefits



- Library provides cities with SOA cycling advocacy technologies.
- Plug & play games/apps help keep local solutions popular.
- Best practices help cities build better local solutions.
- Marketplace supports co-creation of cycling apps/games/tech.

Pitch Criterion 1: Relevance



The Challenge:

Increase *effectiveness* of public support for cycling infrastructure.

Assessment:

- → Engages more people using games.
- → Efficiently guides people to cycling input and advocacy opportunities.
- → Helps cities and groups create effective participation applications.
- → Helps developers market their applications and software.

Pitch Criterion 2: Scalability



Commercial potential:

- →Game + Website approach can be applied everywhere.
- → Platform improves market for, and quality of, participation software.

Competitive advantage:

- → No existing platforms for local cycling public participation software.
- → Platform supports co-creation: software developer clients.
- → Platforms are next logical step in software development.

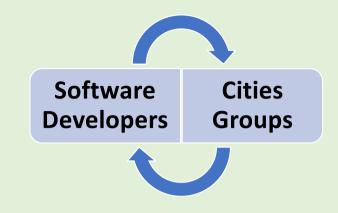
Pitch Criterion 3: Innovation



Existing best practices applied to cycling advocacy:

- → Platform approach for co-creation.
- →Using games for engagement and learning.
- → Marketplace for state-of-the-art cycling software ...
 - ... prevents cities/groups from re-inventing the wheel.

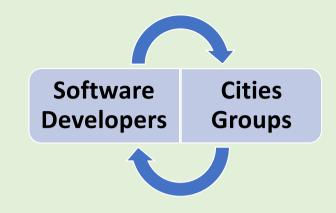
Next Steps



Option 1: Local Customers

- \rightarrow ± 5 cities hire us/local developers to create *city games + websites*.
- → Lisbon city project coordinated by local partner: João Bernardino.
- → Local project sponsors and developers start *platform*.

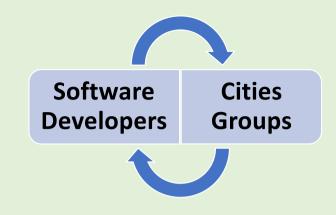
Next Steps



Option 2: Platform First

- → Start working group to manage *platform development* (contact me).
- → Build platform as part of another project (e.g., CIVITAS, EUDRES).
- → Cities and groups use platform to make local *games + websites*.
