Otto Wagner Stadtbahn Tours

Otto Wagner (1841-1918) was a pioneer of Modern Architecture. In 1894 he began work on design of Vienna's Stadtbahn (city railway). The Stadtbahn lines are still used by Vienna's U-Bahn (underground) and S-Bahn (regional rail) systems. MH = Otto Wagner: Majolikahaus

KS = Otto Wagner: Steinhof Church

SH = Otto Wagner: Schutzhaus

DL = Otto Wagner: Donau Lock + Bridge

HM = Hundertwasser Museum

HH = Hundertwasser House

HP = Hundertwasser Power Plant

Otto Wagner - Wiental Stadtbahn Tour (U-4)

- PS = Start at Otto Wagner's masterpiece Postsparkasse (Ringstrasse)
- ... Walk along the Ringstrasse, through the Stadtpark to
- SP = Stadt Park: Almost original Stadtbahn station, recently restored.
- KL = Karlsplatz: Sunflowers station. Otto Wagner Pavilion Museum (Wien Museum).
- Naschmarkt ... If you walk the next section you go right through the Naschmarkt.
- **KB** = Kettenbrücke: Otto Wagner: Majolikahaus, another masterpiece.
- MG = Margareten Gürtel: view of Otto Wagner's Wientalbrücke (bridge).
- SB = Schönbrunn: Almost original Stadtbahn station.
- Schönbrunn ... Palace museum, garden, zoo.
- O | | Hietzing: Otto Wagner: Kaiser Pavilion, private railway station (Wien Museum).
- SV = Unter St. Veit: Catch 47a bus to Steinhof Hospital (check if grounds open!)
- KS = Walk through hospital grounds to Otto Wagner: Steinhof Church (Wien Museum).

Otto Wagner – Donau Kanal Tour (U-4)

- PS = Start at Otto Wagner's masterpiece Postsparkasse (Ringstrasse)
- ... Hundertwasser Museum HM and Hundertwasser Haus HH (housing) are 10-15 min walk from Ringstrasse.
- ... Walk along Ringstrasse to Franz Josef Kai, across bridge, then downstairs and along the quay to ...
- SH = Shottenring: Otto Wagner Schutzhaus (cross back under Kanal via U-2 station!)
- RL = Rossauer Lande: Pavilion station: Nearby Servitenstrasse is an urban oasis ... food, drinks, shops.
- FB = Friedens Brücke: Pavilion station.
- Karl Marx Hof = Heiligenstadt: Karl Marx Hof, Waschsalon Museum, bus 38a to Grinzing Heurigen & Vineyards!
- ... and/or walk from Heiligenstadt Station to Otto Wagner: Donau Kanal Lock & Bridge (10-15 min).

Otto Wagner – Gürtel Line Tour (U-6)

- MG = Start Margareten Gürtel U-4 Station ... walk in park to Otto Wagner's Wientalbrücke, then further to
- **GS** = Gumpendorfer Strasse: elevated station with viaduct extending north.
- | Josefstäter Strasse: elevated station (Tram 2 to Ottakringer Station | OK | OK | ON Vororte Line Tour).
- w = Währinger Strasse: elevated station, beautiful viaducts over busy streets.
- N = Nussdorfer Strasse: elevated station, tram 38 to Grinzing Heurigen & Vineyards!
- O = Spittelau U-4/U-6 station: Hundertwasser Power Station | P , connection to Donau Kanal Tour.
- O = Neue Donau U-6 station: Vienna's wonderful 21-km Donau Insel park along the Danube.

Otto Wagner – Vororte (Suburban) Line Tour (S-Bahn: S-45)

- OK = Start Ottakringer U-3/S-Bahn Station: elevated station ... (bus 46a to Steinhofgrunde & Church KS)
- H = Hernals: elevated station, well preserved most interesting station on this tour.
- **G** = Gersthof: elevated station.
- O = Heiligenstadt: Karl Marx Hof, Waschsalon, Grinzing, Donau Kanal Lock (see Donau Kanal Tour).
